

Rebel Band Booster Meeting
Lee High Library
Sept. 8, 2011
8:00 p.m.

Alex King called to order the meeting following the trial inspection of the band in the Lee courtyard. Those officers in attendance were as follows; Alex King, Grace King, Barb Peacock, Tracy Bacon, Robert Bacon, Dana Hyatt, Max Floyd, Tina Walton, Jill Smith, Dawn Gagliardi, LaDonna Harland and Mr. Storie.

The first order of business was a vote to adopt the agenda for tonight's meeting. Alex King made the motion, it was seconded and adopted. The Executive Board was introduced to the booster club. There was no unfinished business since this was the first full booster club meeting of the year.

The new business of the meeting was to vote on Dawn Gagliardi being approved to be the Accounts Payable Treasurer to replace Melanie Winchester. Alex King made the motion to approve, it was seconded and it was adopted. Alex King also made the motion to approve the 2011-2012 band budget. Mr. Maytubby made a motion to make an addendum to the budget to purchase more gauntlets for the band uniform since it was already approved in a previous budget. Alex King made the motion to approve the budget, it was seconded and approved with adjustments that may happen during the year.

The Executive board and committee reports followed with fundraising from Tracy Bacon. She reported that the express sale has ended. The Coco-Cola fundraiser will be in Oct., doormats will be in Nov. for \$10.00, Christmas ornaments will be sold for \$38.00 and can be pre-ordered on the website. Dana Hyatt is checking with local restaurants for a Lee High band night where the booster club will receive profits from the evening. Tina Walton will need food for the Tall City Marching contest for judges. Barb Peacock reported that at the beginning of the meeting there were 92 parent members with an opportunity for more to join tonight. Jill Smith reports on assessments that have been collected to this date being \$34,831.00. She commented that most students have paid the \$300.00 assessment. The strong sale of show shirt ads this year helped many students to reach this assessment amount. Barb Peacock also reported that more information and volunteer opportunities will be coming as the Tall City Marching contest will be held on Oct. 8th at Grande Stadium. There will be a committee meeting on Sept. 13th for those wanting to work on the Tall City Marching Contest. Beth Stoezel went over several instructions on the caring of and wearing of the band uniform at the inspection held in the courtyard.

Mr. Storie had an opportunity to make a few comments. He wants to put together a roster for the band to help with communication. Parents can purchase ads for their own child to as well as companies in the Tall City Marching program.

Alex King announced that we will try to have band booster club meetings monthly as much as possible. The next meeting is set for October 17, 2011.
