- May meeting minutes were reviewed, one change was made, and approval was motioned by Katy Reid and seconded by Jeanette Reyes

Fundraising Update

- Fundraising
 - Spirit Wear Sales
 - We will make a 50% profit on all t-shirt and hoodie sales
 - Spirt wear will take about a week if we have to order, so we will try to keep our inventory up
 - The on-line shop owes us for sales from last year
 - Muster
 - Freshman Muster is July 27, 2023. Board members will cover the table
 - High School Muster is July 31-August 1st. We will send out volunteer sigh ups to cover the tables
 - Profit Share
 - Texas Road House either August 23rd or September 20th. Amber will confirm and then we will start sending flyers out
 - Blue Sky October 11th
 - Chuy's will be in November
 - Kendra Scoot in February

- Calendar Fundraiser
 - Will kick off at Parent meeting August 3rd. This fundraiser is optional for students. Students will make \$496/calendar. Students receive 100% profit
- Yard Signs
 - Will kick off at Parent meeting August 3rd. This fundraiser is mandatory. Students will have opportunities to sell them at the mall, and at home. We are asking students to sell 20 signs a piece. Signs cost \$20/per sign. Students will make \$13/per sign.

Receivables Treasurer Report

- Submitted a monthly report on deposits in June and July
 - Band Assessments- \$1,973.00
 - Corporate Sponsorship-\$11,079.63
 - Booster Club- \$97.02
 - Semi-Truck- \$22,500.00
 - Alumni- \$650.76
 - Total Deposits- \$36,300.41
- Assessment Fees
 - 5 students have signed up for ACH Payments
 - 6 students have paid assessment fees in full
 - 3 students have paid more then \$200 towards assessment fees
 - 38 students have made a payment towards assessments fees
 - 129 students have not made a payment
 - 22 students have not paid from the past 2 years totaling \$20,871.00
 - 8 students from last year did not make a payment totaling \$4,000.00
 - 13 students owned more the \$250.00 totaling \$4,600.00
 - 18 students owed less than \$250.00
 - Total debt from assessments is \$31,016.00
- Cuttime update
 - All students have been imported as of yesterday. This is a link that will be on your phone. You will be able to see your fees, what you have paid, and what you owe. There will be a 3% processing fee that will apply to all payment.
 - At the parent meeting, we will make a push to have parents sign up for ACH payments, and cuttime.
- Sponsorship update
 - 10 Sponsors as of July 24, 2023 totaling \$17,500. Still waiting on 2 payments.

Payables Treasurer Report

- What we have paid out
 - Spirit inventory \$13,000.00
 - Paid Music arranger
 - Paid for the dot of the practice field. They will be there Friday to paint them
 - Paid for symbols we order last year. They have been on back order
 - Put a deposit on the color guard customs
- School Distract approved budget
 - They will pay \$11,000 for the 5 new podiums. Podiums totaling \$13,700. They will be asking the boosters to cover the rest of the cost.

- They will continue to pay for Friday night meals
- Supply and repair budget will stay the same
- They will pay \$800 for the directors for professional development

Vice President Report

- Platoon Parent Volunteers
 - Will try to get parents phone numbers
 - Make QR codes for every section for the parent meeting
 - Will come up with guidelines to try to make a push to get more people involved.

President Report

- Extravabandza August 5th in Cafeteria
 - More info to come as time gets closer. Will send out a sign up for volunteers
- Summer Band Concert August 18th
 - Boosters will do a concession stand as a fundraiser
- Semi-Trailer has been fully funded
 - Will go before MISD board July 25th at the board meeting. Once approved MISD will match us, and we will be able to order. They will then call Mr. Dojahn to start working on the interior. It will take about 6 months for it to be complete.
 - We have a few outstanding grants. If those come though we would like to replace the trailers and buy a Polaris
- Hawaii Trip
 - May 28th has been proposed as the start date
 - It will cost roughly \$3,500/per person, still working on the cost for chaperones.
 - Would like 10 chaperones to come. They will have to go through application process. More info to come at the parent meeting.
- Water Jugs
 - Purchased new Under Amour jugs from Acdemdy. New jugs will cost \$30.00
 - There are still a few old jugs that will be for sale. These will cost \$15.00
 - Students will not be required to purchase a jug.
- Alumni Association
 - We have 22 members to date. 15 have paid in full. We would like to get 50 members
 - We will be extending the deadline from August 1st to August 15th
- Banking Updates
