#### **Proceedings:**

- Meeting called to order by Amber Pena at 6:01pm
- February meeting minutes were reviewed, and approval was motioned by Larry Lozano and seconded by Dina Higginbotham

### Fundraising Update (Jennifer Washam):

- Fundraising
  - Jennifer is planning to meet with representatives from a company called Just Fundraising- they have 30+ ideas for brochure fundraising (Mr. Dojahn asked for Jennifer to ask how the products are delivered and how much time will be required to sort)
  - o Texas Roadhouse Roll fundraiser will be coming for Thanksgiving
  - Discussed the need to have more fundraisers next year due to the increased cost of the band trip next year
  - Will start planning the profit-sharing nights soon
  - Still have 22 chocolate boxes outstanding (12 students) and 11 popcorns outstanding (7 students)
  - Popcorn fundraising did well (placed two orders)

### Payables Treasurer Report (Helga Hoban):

• Submitted the new budget for next year

- Will be splitting the budget in to two parts starting next year- Program Budget (includes items related to the marching show, clinicians, etc.) and the Operating Budget (includes booster expenses)
- o Approval was motioned by Katy Reid and seconded by Jennifer Washam (none were opposed)
- Budget items discussed:
  - Next year the band will wear "power tops" instead of the regular tops
  - The props will be purchased instead of parent built next year
  - The Henshaws will continue as show designers/coordinators next year
  - Funds transferred to student trip
  - Sponsorships are the biggest income item (helps with operating costs)- will be due August 1st
  - Individual student picture sitting fee
  - Removed the visiting team baskets and bereavement (will move to parent volunteers)
  - Reduced the awards line item
  - Removed part of the color guard uniform (students will buy)
- $\circ\quad$  Mr. Dojahn reviewed what items MISD pays for:
  - Drill Designer Fee (\$15,000)
  - Student Meals (\$76,000)
  - General Supplies- sheet music, drum major podiums (\$21,000)
  - Travel Fees (\$77,000)
  - Student Lodging (\$6,000)
  - Contest Fees (\$9,800)
  - Instrument Repair Fees and Miscellaneous Supply Fees (\$13,000)
  - Contracted Services (\$15,000)
  - Total: \$219,000
- Discussed that we have a ten-month cash reserve and need to come up with a project to use some of the reserve
  - If MISD does not cover the drum major podiums, this will be first
  - New carrier for the tech board
  - Director stand
- Uniform changes were discussed
  - Discontinuing the band polo and traditional under uniforms
  - $\circ$   $\;$  Will wear the show shirt and certain color athletic shorts
  - Caps no longer be required, but no other caps allowed

- The Hotel/Motel Tax Grant application will be reviewed tomorrow (looks promising- potential \$60,000 grant)

## Vice President Report (Christina Valencia):

- Band Banquet Update
  - Currently 116 tickets have been sold
  - Working on programs (waiting on award names)
  - Decorations have been ordered and the committee will meet on Thursday, May 18<sup>th</sup> at 5pm to decorate the venue
  - Menu has been finalized (fajitas)
  - o Discussed the need to have security officers to keep the kids out of trouble
  - Larry was asked to develop a slideshow to play in the background during the banquet
  - Doug Russell Pool has been reserved for a social event on July 22<sup>nd</sup> (Summer Band Kickoff)
- Next year there will be a Social Coordinator student to help plan social events

## President Report (Amber Pena):

- Semi-Trailer fundraiser update- we are at 50% of our goal (\$50,000) -discussed expanding the advertising sales
- Requested volunteers to serve on the financial audit committee- Katy, Larry and Samantha stepped up to help
- Discussed changes to the sponsorship form
  - Added Jazz Band concert as an option for the gold and platinum sponsors (previously was only a marching band performance)
  - Added two complimentary tickets to band banquet
- Cleaning day scheduled for this Saturday and asked for help to come 9-12noon
- Alumni Association Update
  - Pushing out through Facebook initially and dues will be \$50 annually (half to pay for items they receive and the other half to go for scholarships)
  - We will have a alumni football game and a quarterly newsletter with a Director's note, Booster President note, student note and possibly an alumni spotlight section
  - Amber has reached out to Norm Johnson to possibly design magnets to be given out with dues payment
  - The registration form will go out the first week of June with memberships active from August 1<sup>st</sup>- August 1<sup>st</sup>
  - Discussed the importance of making the first year as organized as possible to set a good tone for the program
- Amber wants to have a board retreat to discuss items that didn't work or worked well last year (will send out a poll with scheduling possibilities)
